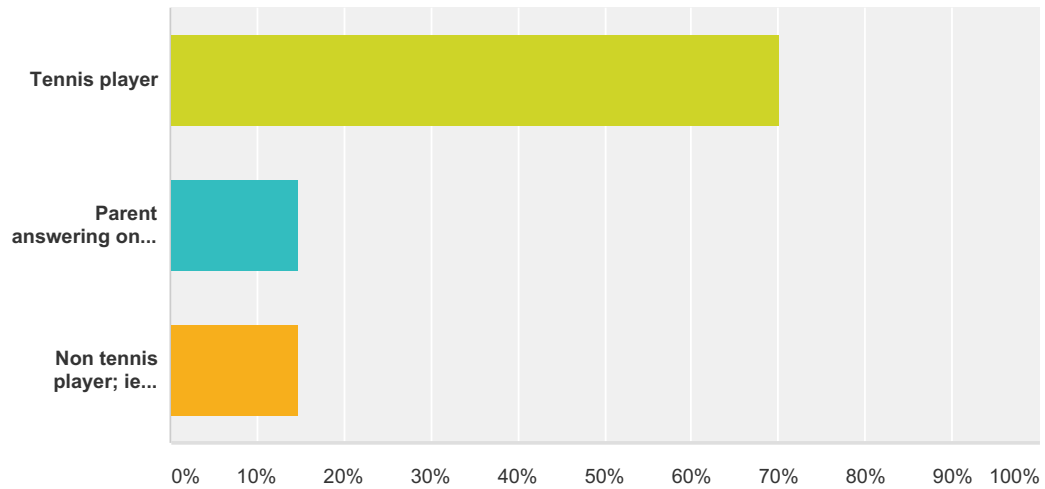


### Q1 Are you a tennis player or support person ie; parent of junior, volunteer, committee member etc?

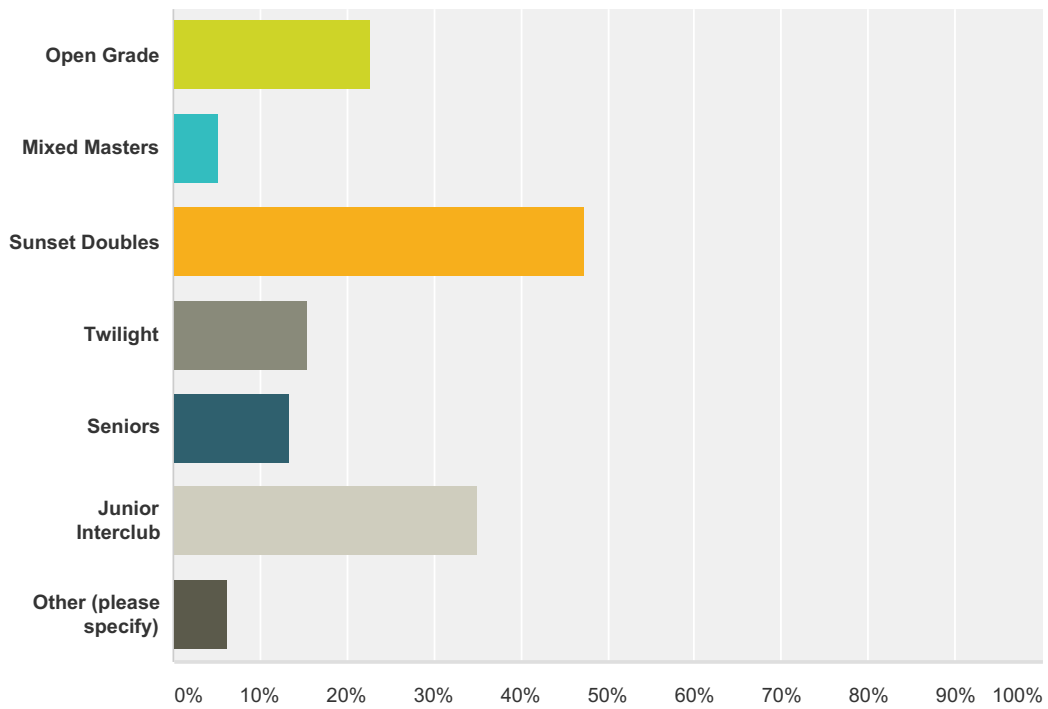

### Q2 What competitions do you play? (You may select more than one answer)

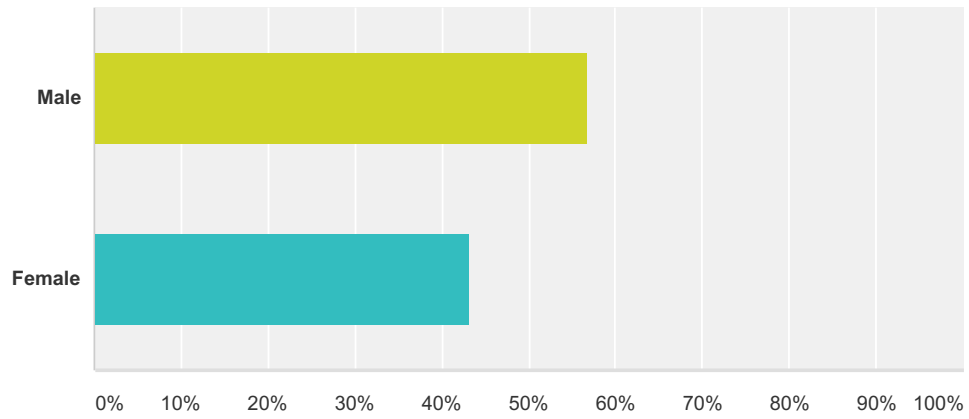

### Q3 Gender?

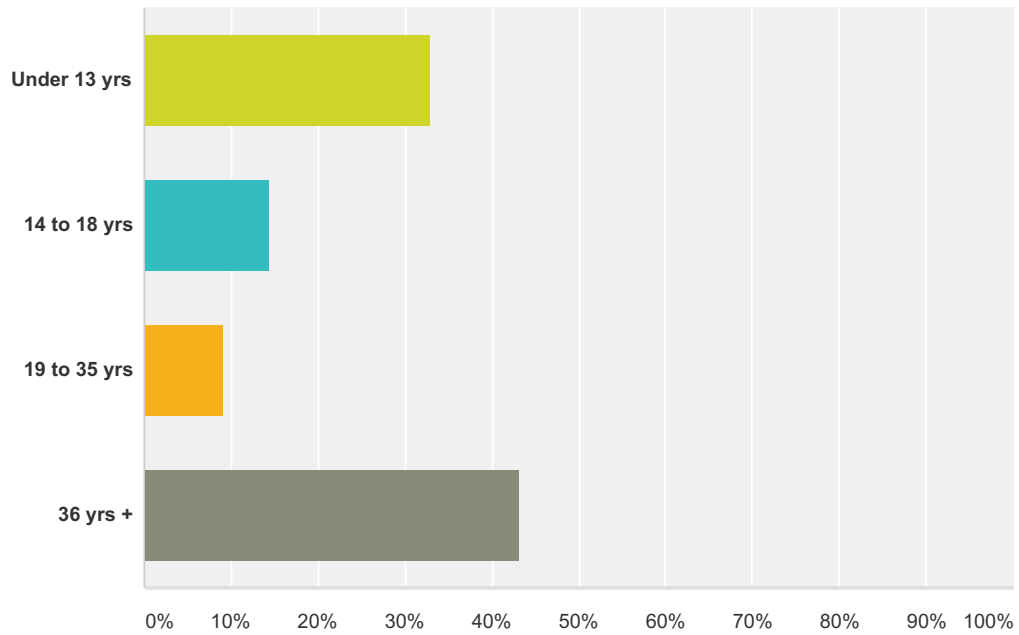

### Q4 Please select your age group

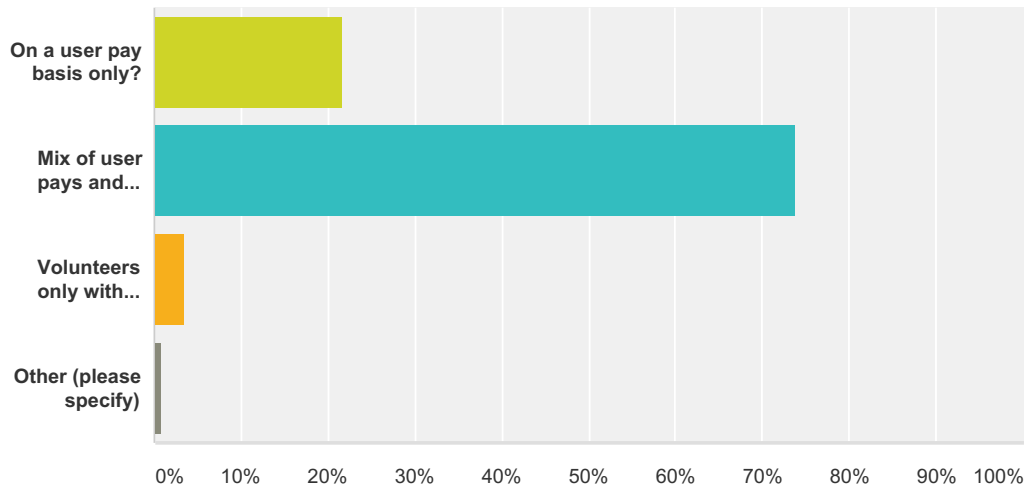

### Q5 How do you think that all tennis competitions, facilities and administration should be paid for?

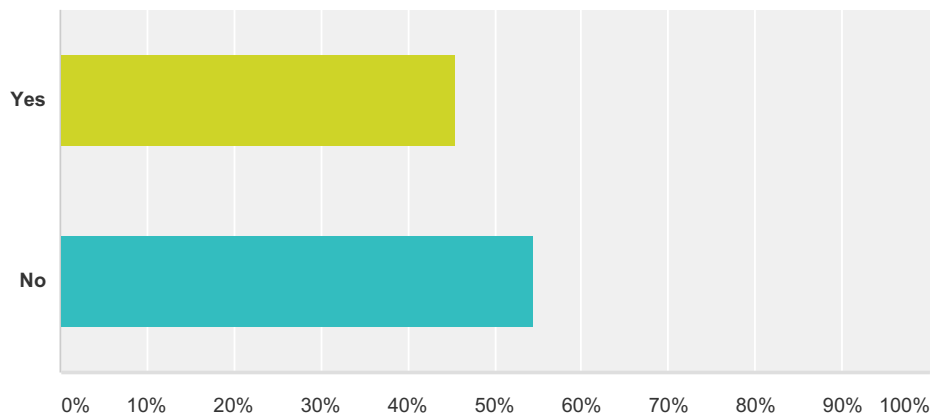

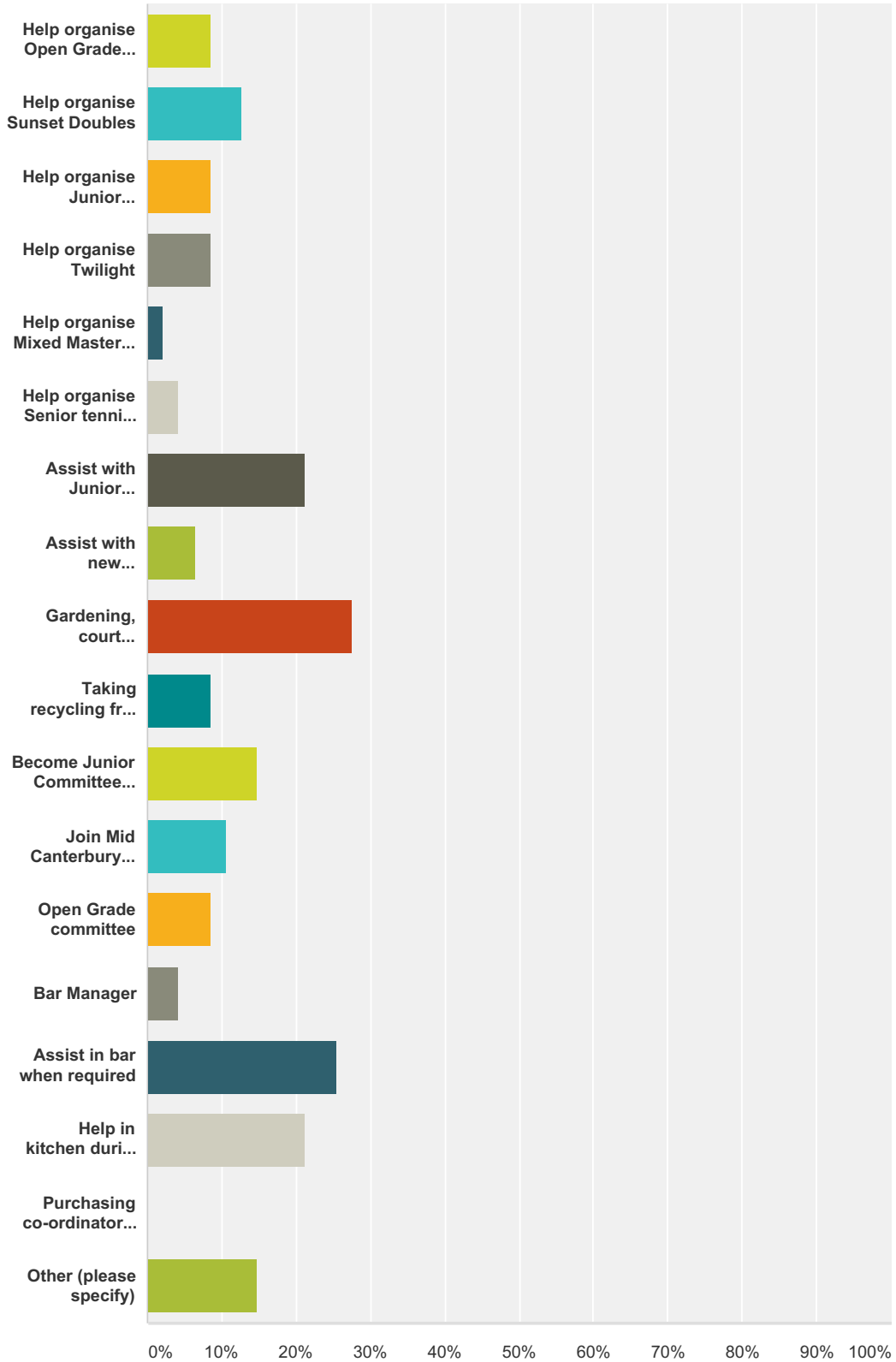

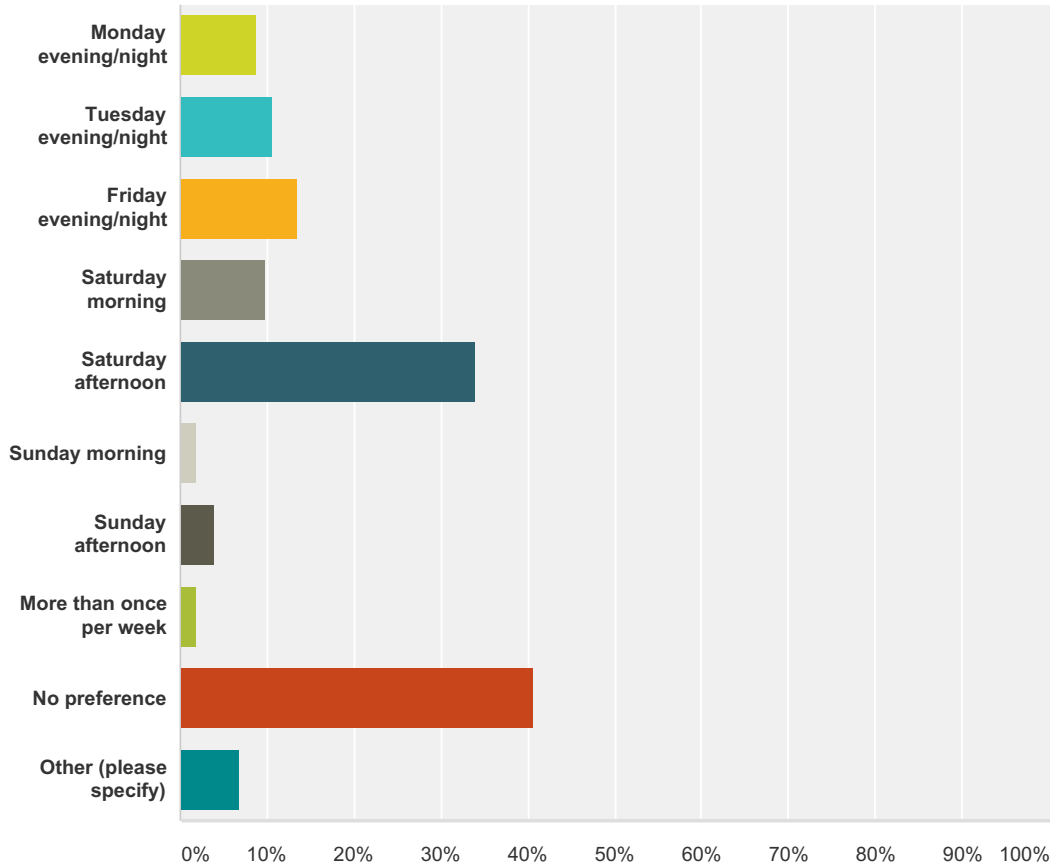

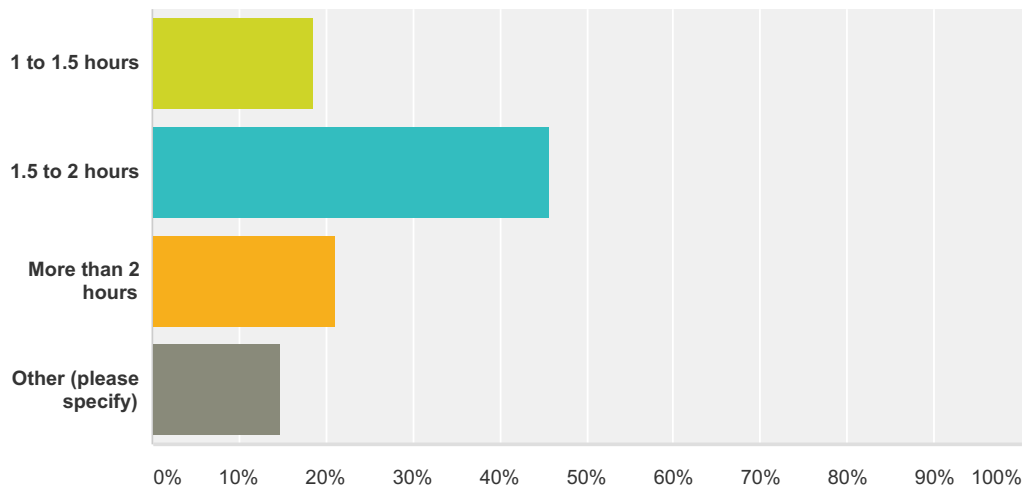

### Q11 How long would you like Open Grade Interclub matches to go for?

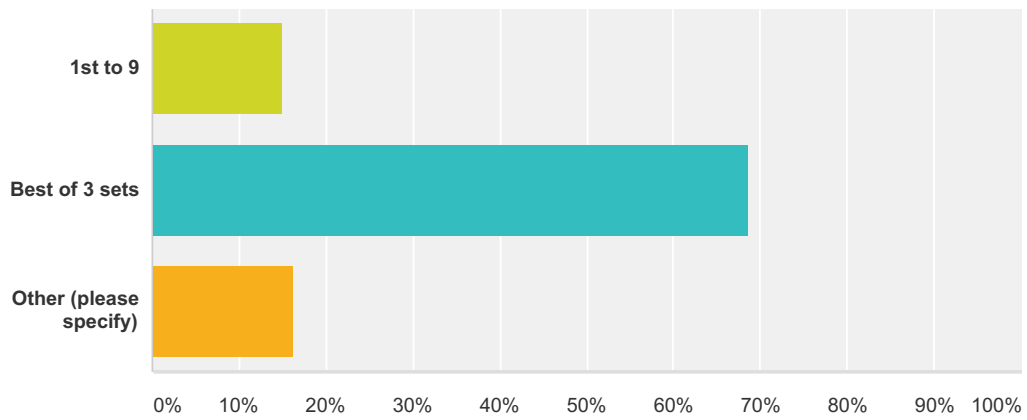

### Q12 What format would you like Open Grade Interclub to be?

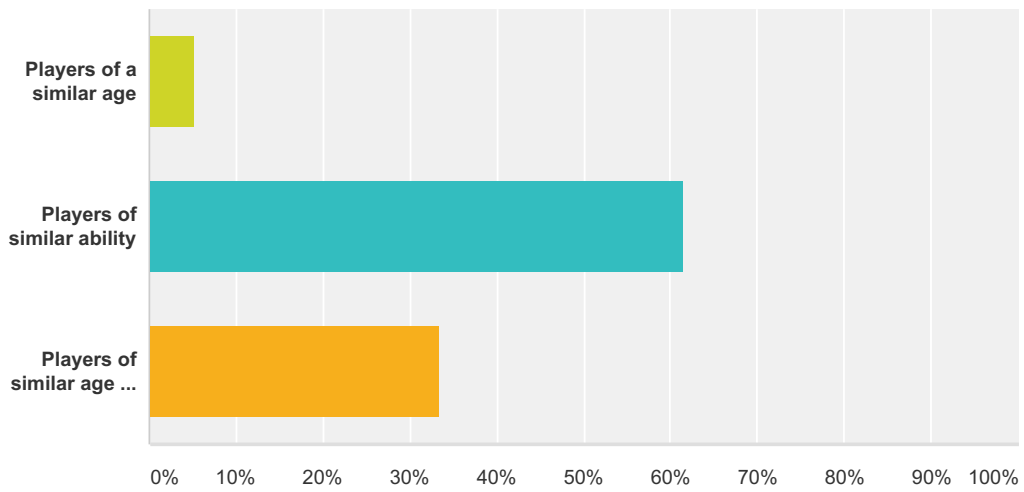

### Q13 In Open Grade Interclub would you prefer to play against

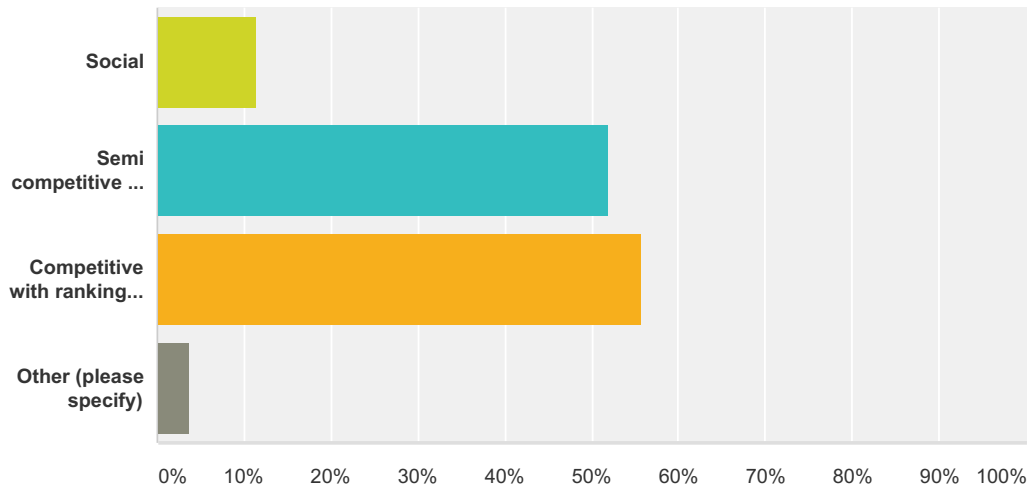

### Q14 In Open Grade Interclub what level of competition would your prefer? (You may select more than one answer)

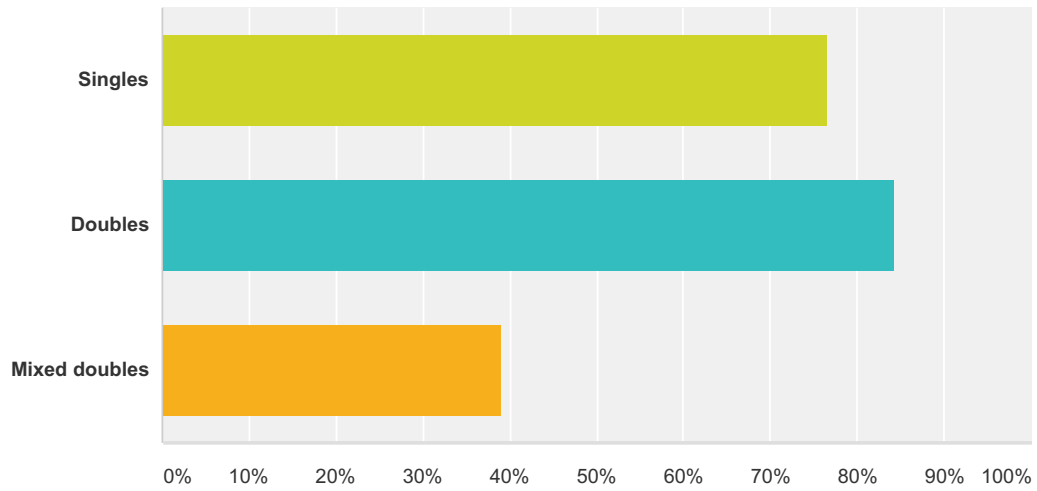

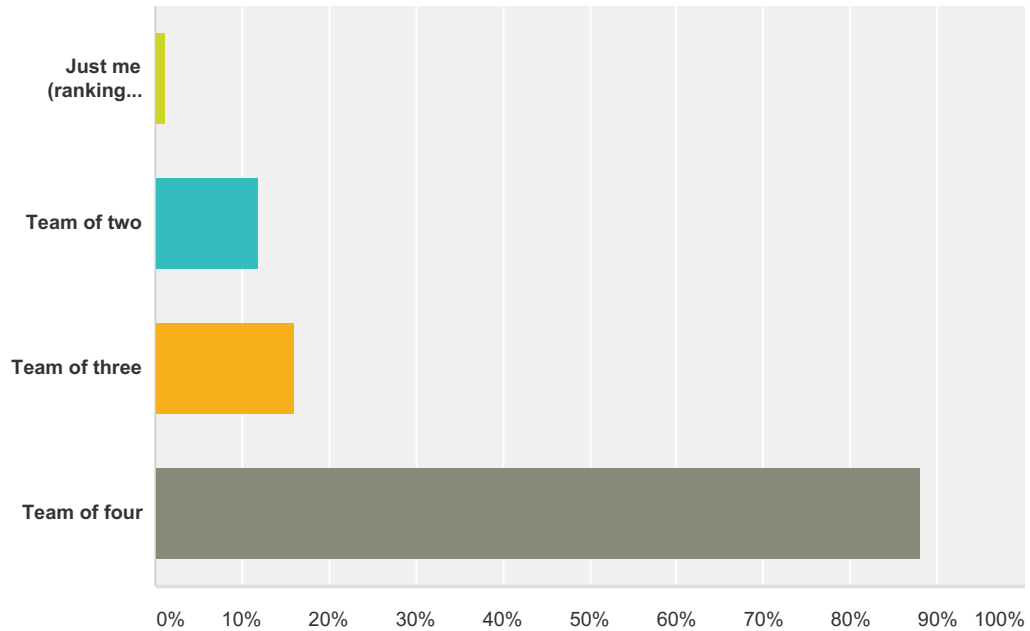

### Q16 In Open Grade Interclub how many players would you like to have in your team? (You may select more than one answer)

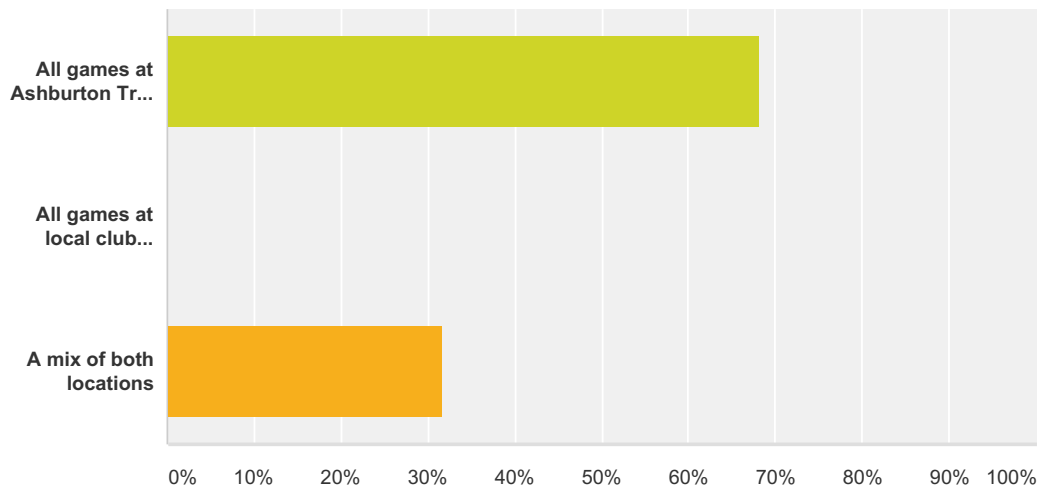

### Q17 Where would you prefer to play Open Grade Interclub?

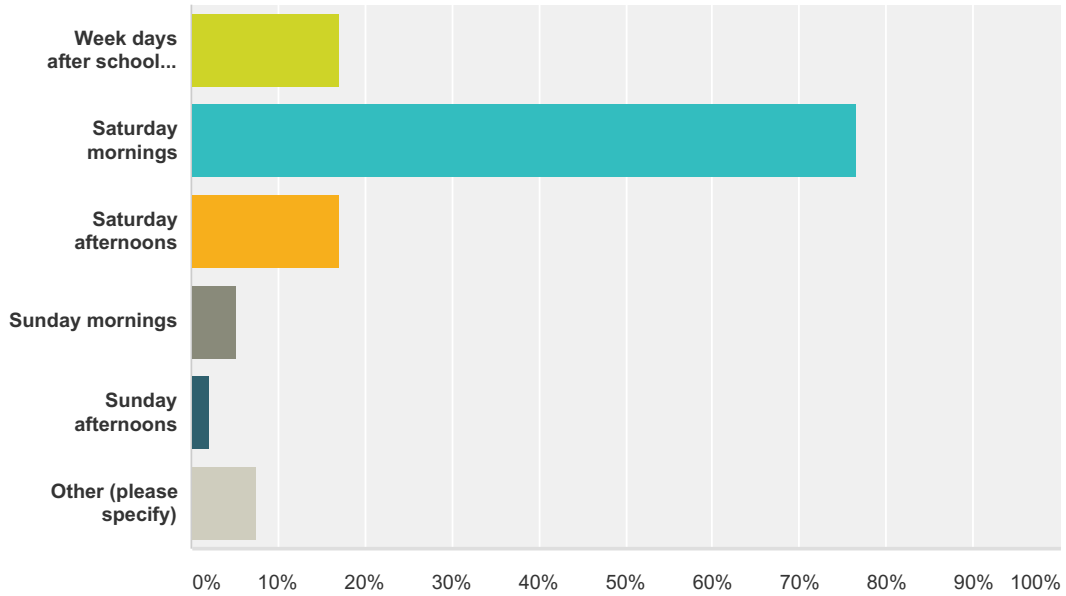

### Q18 When would you prefer Junior interclub competitions to be played? (You may select more than one answer)

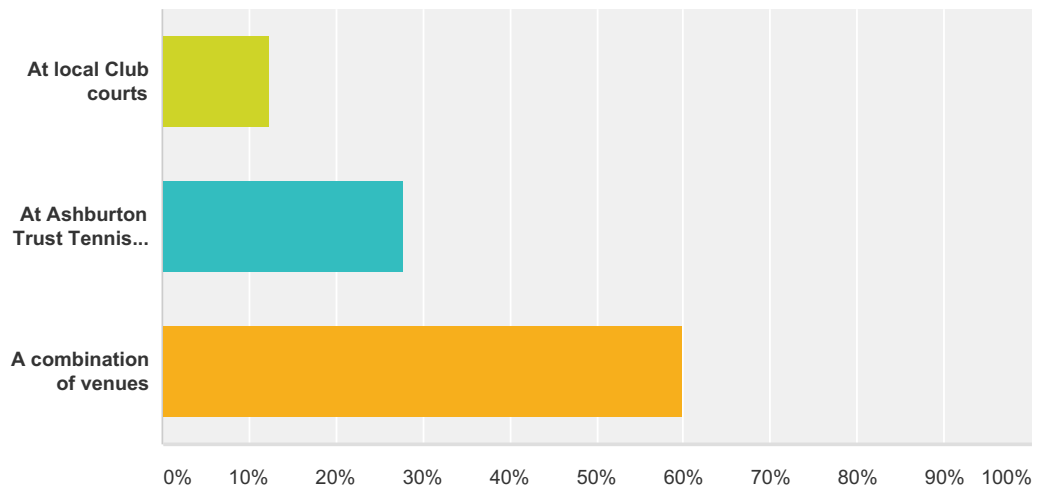

### Q19 Where would you prefer Junior Interclub competitions to be played?

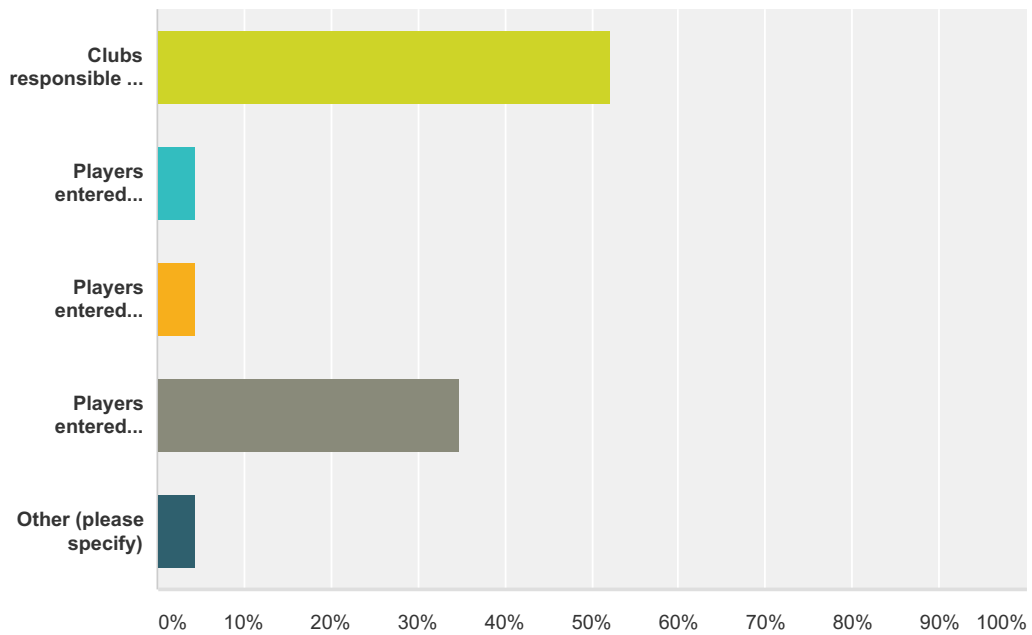

### Q20 How should Junior Interclub teams be put together?

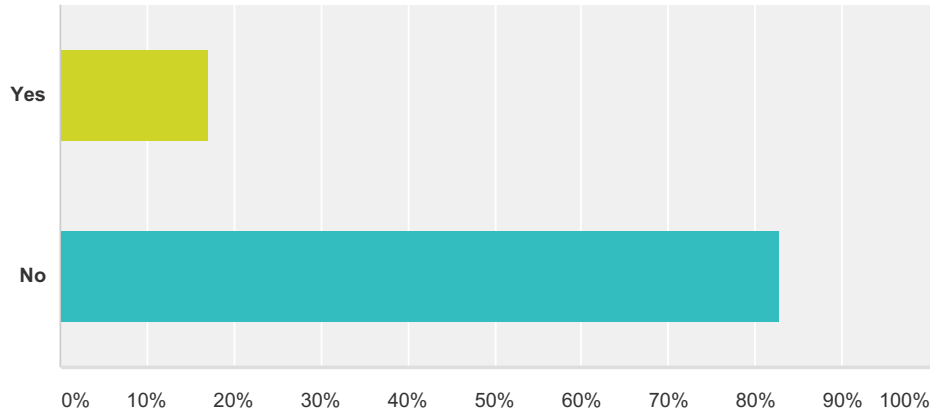

### Q21 Would you be prepared to pay significantly higher fees to continue to play on grass courts?

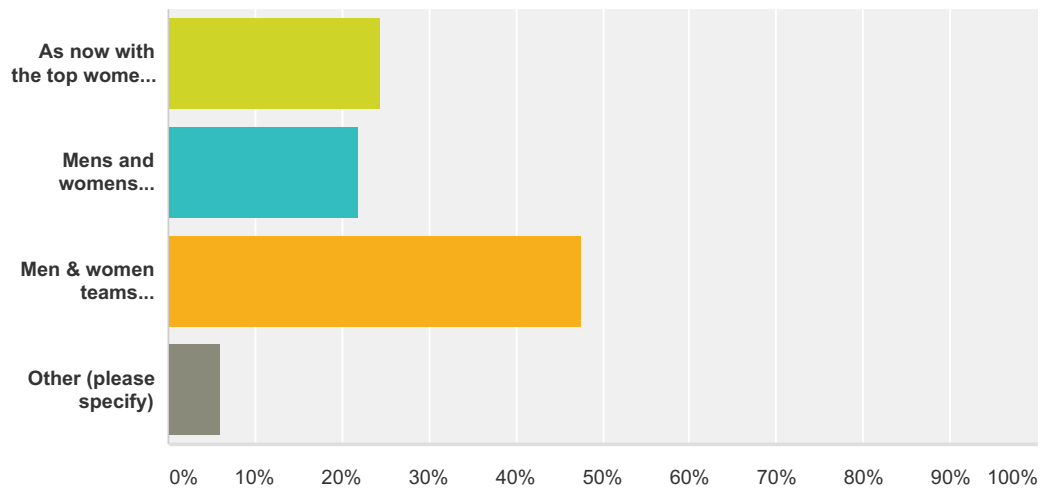

### Q22 How should the sections in Sunset Doubles be organised?

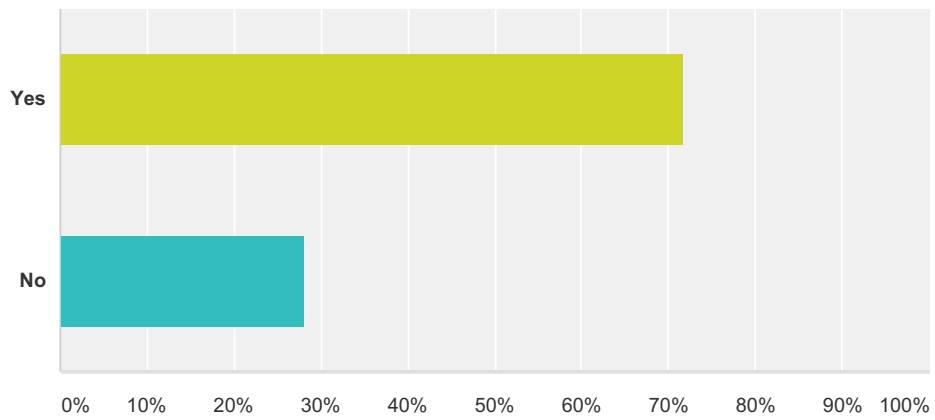

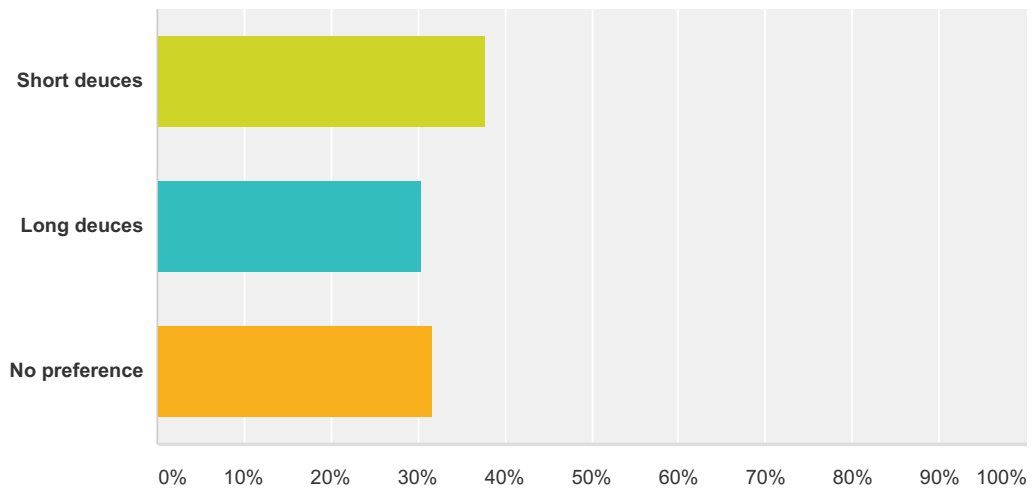

### Q24 In Sunset Doubles would you rather play

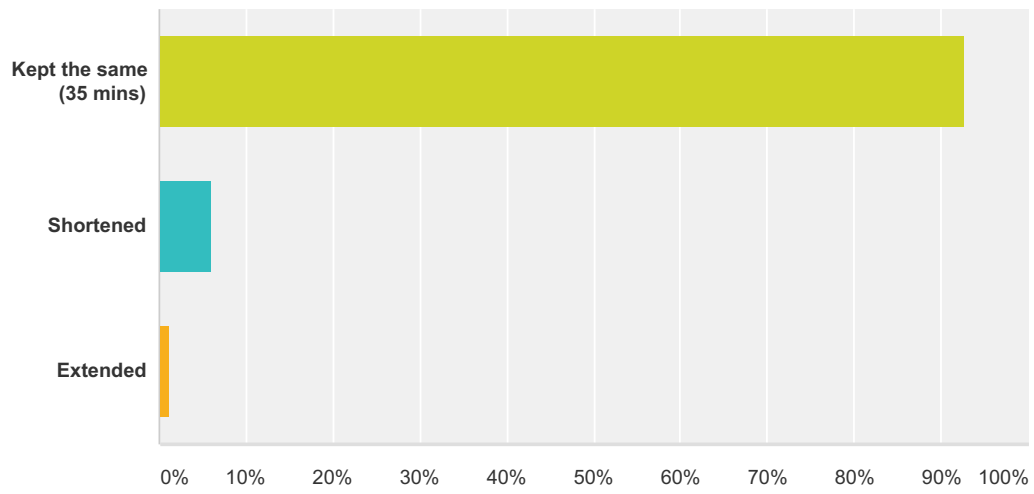

### Q25 In Sunset Doubles should the length of games be

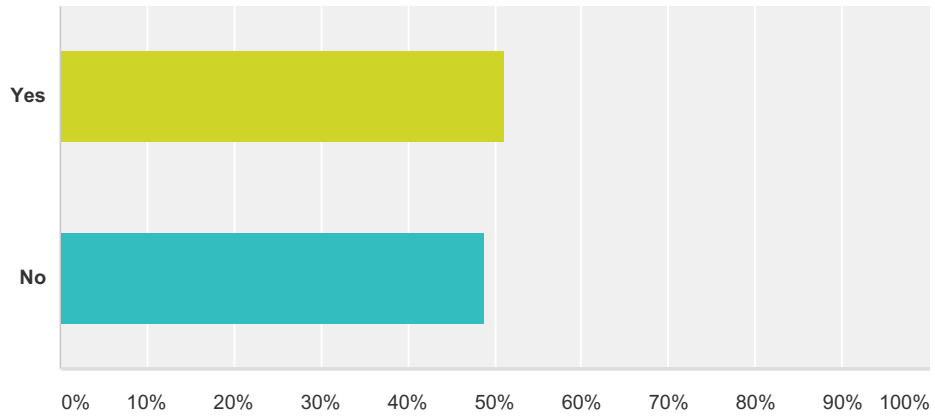

**Q26 Would you be interested in a casual competition where players just turned up at a set day/time and played individual tennis or competitive team tennis?**

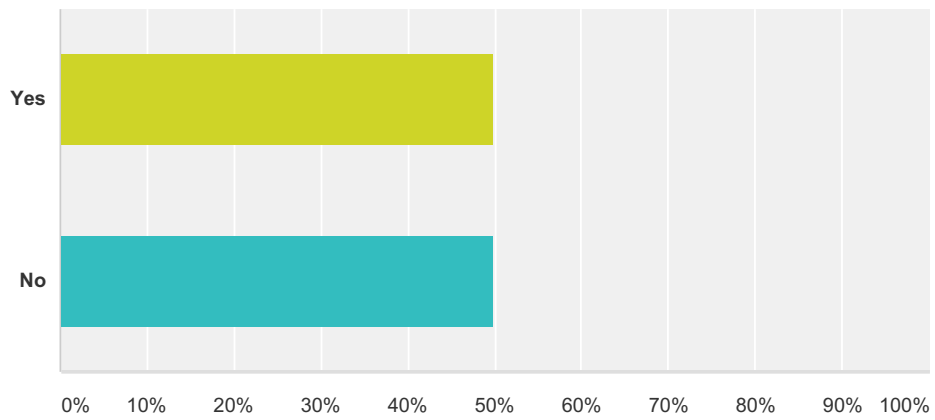

- Out of town teams to play the earlier rounds if possible - late rounds are difficult due to travel times
- Late games for sunset doubles are too late finishing when you travel for 40 mins to get home. It is also a turn off when you get a run of late games.
- Get a Facebook page, more common way to communicate now
- Late round of sunset doubles is very late for teams travelling big distances - all members of our team were very reluctant to play the late round.
- A single evening comp should be held as I prefer singles it lifts my game and more competitive .
- Sunset competition seems to lose its way in the last 2-3weeks of competition. Without notification teams have not turned up this has happened 2 years in a row.

- Junior tennis the last four years has had not enough committment from Junior players parents etc and expects to much from the Board and gets to much for the effort and small financial return Mid Canterbury gets from Junior tennis . Going forward the Coach/Club Manager needs

to be focusing on all aspects of tennis . and to assist in this he or she needs to establish a good working communication relationship with each committee or person responsible for their competitions .

- Regrade teams after one round. Try to avoid BYES. The tennis season is so short anyway with rain interruptions and tournament weekends that not all players play in. It's not effective to only play once a month because there has been a bye, then a rained off weekend then a tournament weekend.
- Sunset doubles. It is brilliant and the organisers excellent. We do need to know the rules at the start ie promotion relegation first round or second round or both. We need to know the format after Christmas. It is a fact of life (and we get by) that fielding teams after Christmas is an issue. If the rounds after Christmas, or some of them, are meaningless the competition loses a lot at the end effecting end of season function and possibly enthusiasm of some, remembering its your last games of the season which you do bring to mind when you look at entering next.
- Saturday A grade needs to be better sorted, the standard isn't there and for older players to play Something needs to be done! I don't want to play young kids who aren't good enough!! I would love to play, and maybe mid week is the answer, but unless your number one, your not going to have a decent game on a Saturday
- Survey took too long and was biased
- I would like to see sunset doubles begin earlier in the evenings so the last games don't finish so late.
- When entering junior teams it is often hear to know which grade to enter them into as the ability in the grade as whole can vary from year to year, some advice on the most appropriate grade for a given team would be most appreciated.
- Once the teams are made up, it is still hard to know which grade to enter them in as ability within a grade varies from year to year, some advice from someone who know the likely strength of the grade in a given year would be great.
- Advertise the Wednesday night tennis better especially the 2nd grade. It's a great night and organised really well but not enough players.
- Coming from Christchurch where I have played Senior Women and Div 1 Women has been interesting. The lack of interest in some young players who are playing the top grade is disappointing. They couldn't care less. I had one young lady pretty much have a tantrum when I bet her. Not used to that sort of attitude which I feel should be snapped out at junior level. Tony does a great job organising interclub. Shame there are not many young ladies coming through to the top level..
- With the Wednesday night social doubles the 2nd grade struggle to find enough teams for the competition. It's really boring always playing the same couple of teams. Can this please be advertised better, maybe a Facebook page or someone going into businesses advertising the Wednesday night game. We are considering not playing this summer if there isn't many teams to play.
